[redacted] reported that an African American male suspect entered the store armed with a revolver and demanded money from the cash register.

NOTICE TO APPLICANT FOR A CHARGING DOCUMENT

You are making an application for a charging document which may lead to the arrest and detention of the individual you are charging. If, as result of your application, a charging document is issued by the commissioner, it will not be possible for the commissioner to withdraw the document. The charge may only be disposed of by trial or by action of the State's Attorney.

You will be required to appear at the trial as a witness. Failure to appear on the date set by the court could result in your arrest for failure to obey a court order.

The application which you are filing is being filed under oath. Criminal Law Article § 9-503, of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides that any person who makes a false statement or report of a crime or causes such a false report or statement to be made to any official or agency of this State, knowing the same, or any material part thereof, to be false, and with intent that such official or agency investigate, consider or take action in connection with such statement or report, shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$500, or be imprisoned not more than six months, or be both fined and imprisoned, in the discretion of the court.

It is essential that your furnish as much information as possible about the offense. To be sure that your information is adequate, your application should clearly state the following:

1. WHO?
Identify the accused, (the person you are complaining about), and identify yourself.
2. WHEN?
The time, day, month and year of the offense.
3. WHERE?
The exact address and street, the city, county and state where the offense happened. Also state whether the offense happened in a private home or in some public place.
4. WHAT?
State exactly what was done to you. For example: if property was taken, describe it and its value; or, if property was damaged or destroyed, indicate the original cost of the item or its replacement value. If you do not know the exact value, estimate it as accurately as possible.
5. WHY?
The facts you give must show the accused intended to commit a criminal act.
6. HOW?
How the accused committed the offense. For example, if you were physically assaulted, were you struck with a fist, a flat hand, kicked, or pushed, or were you struck with an object, such as a club or pipe, etc.? If property was taken, how did the accused get it? If it was destroyed or damaged, how did the accused cause the damage?
7. At the top of the application, you will notice a space marked "DESCRIPTION". The information in this space refers to the **accused**. It is important to furnish as much of this as possible so that the accused may be easily identified.

You are entitled to request that address and telephone number of a victim, complainant or a witness be considered for shielding at the filing of this application.

If you need further assistance in completing your application, please feel free to ask the commissioner.

[redacted] fearing for his safety complied with the suspect's demands and gave him approximately \$1,700.00 U.S. Currency. While the robbery of the store was taking place there were two customers in the store at the time. One of the customers, identified as [redacted] remained in the front of the store and a second customer, identified as [redacted], ran to the backroom of the business. Once the suspect obtained the U.S. Currency from the store's cash register the suspect turned to [redacted] and demanded his money. [redacted] told the suspect that he did not have any money on him. The suspect escorted [redacted] and [redacted] to the backroom where [redacted] was hiding. The suspect then demanded money from [redacted] fearing for his safety complied with the suspect's demand and gave the suspect \$50.00 dollars in U.S. Currency. After getting the money the suspect fled the location on foot. [redacted] followed the suspect out of the store and observed him getting into the driver side of what he believed to be a silver 2 door Honda Accord with a Maryland tag of 4BP2445. The suspect then drove from the scene. No one was injured during this incident. The suspect is described as a M/B, dark complexion, 5'10", 170 lbs, wearing a black coat with a gray/white hood that was up, blue sweat pants with a white stripe down both legs, black mask, and armed with a small black handgun, unknown caliber. [redacted] stated that the suspect in this incident is the same suspect that robbed his store on December 14, 2014 at approximately 7:20 PM.

During the course of the investigation the 911 call was listened to and the tag number that the caller gave as the suspect vehicle was 2BT4475. This is the vehicle the caller observed the suspect get into and drive away in. In addition to

the tag number the caller stated that the car was a Honda. The tag number 2BT4475 is registered to a 2003 Honda, owned by Auto Budget LLC, a rental company located at 7909 Pulaski Highway Rosedale, MD 21237. Further investigation revealed that this vehicle was rented to Stanley Macklin, M/B, D.O.B. 10/05/1979. Mr. Macklin fits the description of the suspect in this incident and currently is on probation for armed robbery. Mr. Macklin Had control of the vehicle from 02/10/2015 at 6:00 PM until 03/07/2015 at 3:48 PM. The vehicle was remotely disabled due to non payment.

On the rental agreement Mr. Macklin gave a phone number of [redacted] as his phone number. Mr. Macklin also gave this same phone number to his probation agent as being his phone number. A request for information concerning this phone number revealed that the number [redacted] is registered to Stanley Macklin through Cricket/AT&T.



Based on Mr. Macklin being a suspect in this incident he was placed under surveillance. [redacted]

Based on the above facts, your writer prays that an arrest warrant be issued for Mr. Stanley Macklin.
